- 1) Drinking or having an open container on a public sidewalk or street.
- 2) Urinating in an alleyway.
- 3) Walking home alone after drinking uptown, or being drunk by yourself.
- 4) Arguing with or running from the cops, OR refusing to move along if told to.
- 5) Throwing anything, especially bottles or cans.
- 6) Grabbing someone or pretending to be fighting or wrestling.
- 7) Hiding the beer if you see the cops enter.
- 8) Admitting to the cops that you are under 21 if asked, or handing them an ID with your age or social security number on it. Don't lie; see below.
- 9) Handing money to someone outside the carryout (liquor control will follow you).
- 10) Handing the beer to someone who looks young and didn't buy it.
- 11) Having a party and not checking who comes in and how old they are.
- 12) Violating the "Noise Ordinance" (10:00pm Sun-Thu, 12:00am Fri and Sat)
- 13) Going inside the old school building at the Ridges.

## **IF YOU ARE CONFRONTED BY THE POLICE:**

- You do not have to consent to a search unless you are already under arrest
- You do not have to answer questions (other than to identify yourself and where you live) unless you have already been arrested.
- If an ID is required, you DO NOT have to provide any particular ID such as a driver's license.
- Ask if you are "in custody". If not, then leave.
- Try to have a witness. Always be polite.
