ORDER

As per the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, the Court finds that a suspension of driving privileges would seriously affect the Defendant/Petitioner's ability to continue necessary occupational, educational, vocational, or medical appointments. Therefore, the court ORDERS that the Defendant/Petitioner be granted limited driving privileges during the period of the license suspension if all terms and conditions as set forth below are complied with during the time of the operation of any motor vehicle during the period of the license suspension.

The conditions which must be complied with so as to exercise limited driving privileges are:

- 1) The Defendant/Petitioner must give and maintain proof of financial responsibility in accordance with Chapter 4509 of the O.R.C.;
- 2) The Defendant/Petitioner must successfully complete a 72 hour driver intervention program or course of remedial driving instruction if/as ordered by separate entry;
- 3) The Defendant/Petitioner, at the time of the operation of a motor vehicle, must not have ingested or have any presence of concentration of alcohol or any drug of abuse whatsoever in his/her system or bodily substances (blood, breath, or urine) or refuse any chemical test;
- 4) The Defendant/Petitioner must be in compliance, at all times, with the terms and conditions listed on the attached entitled "Athens County Municipal Court – Conditional Driving Permit." Said attachment is fully incorporated herewith;
- 5) All fines and costs due this court must be paid for these privileges to be renewed;
